



## Admission

Beth Tfiloh Dahan Community School, as a member of AIMS (Association of Independent Maryland Schools), abides by the following policy on admission: AIMS schools are committed to the principle of non-discrimination on the basis of race, color, national, and/or ethnic origin.

### Procedure for admission is as follows:

- 1 Children who celebrate their fifth birthday on or before September 1 may apply for Kindergarten. Children who celebrate their fifth birthday between September 1 and December 31 may apply for K-Prep (Gan Aleph).
  - 2 Beth Tfiloh Preschool students applying for K-Prep (Gan Aleph) or Kindergarten must submit a completed Application for Admission and a \$220 non-refundable application/testing fee. Students will be tested during school hours.
  - 3 **Students new to Beth Tfiloh applying for K-Prep (Gan Aleph) through Grade 4** must submit a completed Application for Admission, a Record Release, and a \$220 non-refundable application/testing fee. A test date will be arranged after the Application for Admission has been received.
  - 4 **New students entering Grades 5–12** are required to submit a completed Application for Admission, a Record Release, and a \$50.00 non-refundable application fee. A campus visit and an interview will be arranged on an individual basis. Students are required to take the Independent School Entrance Examination (ISEE), a national admission test used by many independent schools. Students need to test at only one site. **Beth Tfiloh's Sunday testing date is January 11, 2009.**
- 5 Admission decisions are made after careful evaluation of each student's application materials. Notification of admission decisions will be mailed to parents in March 2009.
  - 6 Current Beth Tfiloh students will be mailed re-enrollment contracts at the end of January. A \$700 re-enrollment fee must be submitted with each student's re-enrollment contract. This fee will be applied toward tuition.
  - 7 **Financial Aid:** Indicate your intent to apply for assistance on your application or re-enrollment form, and information will be sent to you.
