

A Guide to the Beth Tfiloh Website

The Beth Tfiloh website provides many valuable resources for our parents and students alike. Our **ACADEMICS** menu includes separate pages for PreSchool, Lower School, Middle School and High School with a wealth of information, documents and multi-media galleries. Every member of our school community has their own password-protected login to provide access a online school **DIRECTORY** and **GROUP** pages, for classes and teams. A **HOMEWORK site** provides assignments for Middle and High School students.

While the Beth Tfiloh public website is accessed by going to www.BethTfiloh.com, parents and students may directly access the login page by going to www.BethTfiloh.com/MyBT and entering in their login and password. Much of our school web content is available on our public website, however certain features, such as the Directory, are reserved only for members of our school community with login access.

FEATURES OF THE SECURE BT WEBSITE

Go to www.BethTfiloh.com/MyBT

Login using your login name and password

Select **“My Groups”** or **“My Child’s Groups”** to see class and team pages

Select **“My Notifications”** to change your email and text message notification settings for important updates and notices, including athletic schedule changes.

Select **“My Profile”** to update your personal information & e-mail address

Select **“Directory”** to access a searchable directory of students, parents, teachers and alumni

Select **“Media Gallery”** to view and download the latest school photos and videos

HOW TO LOGIN - Go to www.beththfiloh.com/MyBT. Parents will enter their first name and last name with no spaces as their login name. Students will enter their first name, last name and their 2 digit class graduation year, with no spaces (e.g. “12” for Grade 12, “15” for Grade 9, “19” for Grade 5). For most users, their temporary password will be their 10-digit home telephone number with no spaces:

Parent Login:	FirstnameLastname	Example - <i>MelanieCohen</i>
Student Login:	FirstnameLastnameYY	Example - <i>JonathanCohen08</i>
Temporary Password:	10-digit home phone	Example - <i>4104861234</i>

The first time you login you will be prompted to enter in a secure password for future logins. Please make a note of it for your records. Passwords are case sensitive.

LOGIN HELP - If you can’t remember your login/password, click **“Login Help”**, enter your e-mail address and follow the directions. Your login information will be sent to the e-mail address you have previously given the school. Be sure to keep the Sign In Help window open while you access the Confirmation Key from your e-mail to reset your password. If you are still having difficulty, call our Help Desk at 410-413-2217.

Homework for Middle and High School students is posted regularly on the BT website. Access the HOMEWORK portal using the **QUICKLINKS** menu. From the HOMEWORK portal, Middle and High School students and parents can view homework assignments with due dates, class schedules, and student information.

IMPORTANT - After you have successfully logged in, you will see a column of menu items on the left hand side of your screen. Click on **MY PROFILE** to review your personal information.

**** Please make sure your correct e-mail address is entered in your PROFILE, since this is the e-mail address the school will be using to communicate with you.** If necessary, use the “Edit” option to enter or update your e-mail address (under “Internet Information”). Once it is entered, it will automatically be used for all future e-mail correspondence.
