## **UNIFORM DRESS CODE**

*Grades Gan Aleph through 4*

*Effective 2008-09 school year*

### **Required Clothing – Boys and Girls**

- 1 ***Polo Shirts*** (Short or Long Sleeved) mesh or interlock with the Beth Tfiloh Dahan Community School Logo in a variety of approved colors are available through Lands' End. At least one polo shirt must be white for special events. **\*\*PLEASE NOTE** that the new Lands End line of "***Fit-For-Her***" polo shirts do not meet the standards of our school dress code and therefore are not on our approved school uniform list. We have notified Lands End of this policy.
- 2 ***Turtlenecks, mock turtles, sweatshirts, sweaters and jackets*** in a variety of approved colors with the school logo are available through Lands' End.
- 3 ***Oxford or chambray shirts and blouses*** with the school logo are available in a variety of approved colors through Lands' End.
- 4 ***Khaki, navy or black chino or corduroy pants***, pleated, tailored, plain-front or elastic waist available at a supplier of your choice. A pocket on the side is acceptable if it is tailored and not obtrusive.
- 5 ***Knee length khaki, navy or black jumpers, skirts, skorts, or longer length shorts*** (shorts only may be worn during the months of August, September, October, April, May and June) available at a supplier of your choice.
- 6 ***Socks or tights*** must be worn with shoes.

### **Unacceptable Clothing**

- 1 Nylon or denim fabric.
- 2 Embellishments of any kind.
- 3 Sweatpants, balloon pants, nylon pants or short shorts. Leggings or stretch "skinny" pants of any fabric that fit like leggings may not be substituted for approved pants.
- 4 Clothing with holes, fraying, patches or clothing that is excessively tight or baggy.
- 5 Excessive or dangling jewelry should not be worn for safety reasons.
- 6 Flip flops.
- 7 Beth Tfiloh "spiritwear" (club and team sweatshirts) are not allowed in the Lower School

Uniform shirts can also be purchased over the summer at the annual Lower School BT "Swap Shop". There parents can purchase used BT uniforms for the reduced cost of \$5.00. All proceeds go to Tzedakah. Please call the office in June for details.

# **BETH TFILOH DRESS CODE – APPROVED COLORS**

Polo Shirts – Mesh or Interlock – Long Sleeved or Short Sleeved – with BT Logo (NOT including “Fit for Her” styles): Black, Grey Heather, Chambray Blue, Ice Pink, Classic Navy, Maize, Cobalt, White

Turtlenecks and Undershirts – Long and Short-Sleeved – To be worn under polo shirt:  
Black, Grey Heather, Chambray Blue, Ice Pink, Classic Navy, Maize, Cobalt, White

Turtlenecks (for Lower School) – Worn as a uniform shirt must have BT Logo: Classic Navy, Maize, White

Oxford Shirts for Her with BT Logo: Blue, White

Oxford Shirts for Him with BT Logo: Blue, French Blue, White  
Long Sleeve Pattern Oxford – Blue/White  
Long Sleeve Chambray – Bleached Indigo

Sweaters with BT Logo: Classic Navy, Maize, White

Fleece / Sweatshirts with BT Logo: Black, Classic Navy, Cobalt, Grey, Heather

## **Addendum**

**S**tudents are expected to stay well within the intent of the dress code. Any student who violates the dress code or repeatedly tests its limits will be subject to disciplinary action.

**I**t will not be necessary for Lower School students to change for Physical Education. Clothing and athletic shoes that are durable enough for the playground are also more than adequate for Physical Education. All students must wear athletic shoes for Physical Education.

**O**n holidays such as Purim or specially designated occasions, the dress code may be lifted and students may be permitted to wear casual or “specialty” clothing. Parents will be notified in advance of these occasions.

**P**ARENTS AND GUESTS ARE ASKED TO DRESS IN A MANNER BEFITTING A JEWISH DAY SCHOOL WHEN THEY ENTER THE BUILDING.
